Grants for Energy Efficiency Upgrades

Federal ecoENERGY Retrofit Homes Program

*Up to \$5000 available
(NOT dependent upon income, NOT taxable)*

The Federal Government offers post-retrofit grants to homeowners who adequately improve their home's energy efficiency. To be eligible, homeowners must first have a pre-retrofit Home Energy Evaluation performed by a licensed Energy Advisor. Homeowners then have up to 18 months to complete any work and have a follow-up evaluation conducted, verifying that retrofits were made.

Prince Edward Island Energy Efficiency Program

*Grant up to \$1500 or loan up to \$10,000
(NOT dependent upon income, NOT taxable)*

The PEI Government provides homeowners with a grant or a loan to help make their houses more energy efficient. The grant will be equal to the sales tax (PST and GST) paid on eligible upgrades to a maximum of \$1500. On window and door upgrades, however, homeowners will instead receive \$30 per qualified unit to a maximum of \$500. The total grant—including the window and door amount—will not exceed \$1500. Loan amounts of up to \$10,000 are available for undertaking all eligible upgrades except for doors and windows. The annual interest rate for this loan is six percent.

Eligibility: To be eligible for federal and provincial grants homeowners must have a home energy evaluation conducted BEFORE they begin retrofits. One initial evaluation qualifies homeowners for both grant programs. Grant amounts are NOT dependent upon income and are NOT taxable.

Cost: The cost of the initial evaluation is \$100 plus tax* for houses up to 2000 sq. ft., including the basement. An additional fee applies for larger homes. The cost of the follow-up evaluation is \$100 plus tax for houses up to 2000 sq. ft., including the basement. An additional fee applies for larger homes.

PEI Assistance Program for Low-Income Households

The PEI Office of Energy Efficiency will pay the full cost of the pre- and post-retrofit evaluations up to a maximum of \$500 for homeowners with a household annual income of less than \$30,000, or for homeowners who receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement or the National Child Benefit. Homeowners who qualify for this program are eligible for interest-free financing if they choose the provincial loan for energy efficiency upgrades.

ecoENERGY Retrofit – Homes Eligible Improvements/Retrofits

In addition to these federal grants, the Province of Prince Edward Island offers property owners a grant of up to \$1500 or a loan of up to \$10,000. The grant will be equal to the sales tax (PST and GST) paid on eligible upgrades to a maximum of \$1500. On window and door upgrades, however, homeowners will instead receive \$30 per qualified unit to a maximum of \$500. The total provincial grant—including the window and door amount—will not exceed \$1500. The federal grant limit is \$5000.
